

Player Pre-Existing Medical Condition

If a player is injured and needs to be transported to hospital it would be useful in certain cases if knowledge of pre-existing medical conditions is available to hospital staff. An example would be in the case of a head injury where information regarding pre-existing medical conditions could not be given by the player.

Below is a suggested medical emergency card that can easily be completed by the player at the start of the season.

The coach should have a card for each player and they should be with the team at all games and practices.
